Brief History of the College

Gossner Theological College (GTC), owned by Gossner Evangelical Lutheran Church (GELC) in Chotanagpur and Assam is located in the region of Adivasi/Tribal (Indigenous communities) people of North-Central India. By God's Grace and the constant prayer, love and support of the believers, helps the college to serve the church and society meaningfully through *basic* and *relevant/contextual* theological education. In the year 2016, GELC celebrated its jubilee (1866-2016), 150 years of existence as *life-witness-service*.

The college has a glorious history of its existence and training ministers and pastors since 1866. Through this long journey, the college regardless of many challenges, have come-up to the level of offering B.D. Course to the called out ones. Initially, the College was started in 1866 by the German Missionaries sent by **Fr. Johannes Evangelista Gossner** from Berlin, Germany who established the first Christian Church of the region in 1845. During the First World War (1914-1919) the college/seminary was closed down and reopened in 1921. During the Second World War (1939-1945) it was shifted to Govindpur and Lohardaga and back to Ranchi in 1948.

With the initiative of the Rev. Dr. J.J.P. Tigga, who was a professor of the History of Christianity at Serampore College, GTC was affiliated to Senate of Serampore College (University) in 1949 for offering *Licentiate of Theology* (L.Th.). Form that time on it was known as Lutheran Theological College. The College was given the present campus in 1965. From 1969, L.Th was upgraded to Bachelor of Theology (B.Th.) and from then on, the institution came to be known as Gossner Theological College. In 1988, a regional collaboration for theological education took place between GELC and Bishob Hubback Theological College (BHTC) of Church of North India (CNI), Chotanagpur Diocese. Consequently, both GTC and BTHC became a mission partner in providing theological education to the region on the 8th of August. In addition, the present administrative building was constructed in 1975. At that stage, an immediate hope was there for upgrading the college from B.Th. to B.D. Degree Course as it became an urgency to provide qualitative theological education to improve and develop the "whole" of young men and women who seek [God's] knowledge and wisdom to serve the Church and Society, but it was not achieved due to some unavoidable circumstance. However, this long cherished dream came into reality on the 150th Year of the church (GELC) Jubilee.

The Senate of Serampore College (University) granted GTC to offer *Bachelor of Divinity* (B.D.) degree course from June 2016. Offering the degree not only brings advanced theological

knowledge, but also creates space for "Adivasi/Tribal Theology," to be more active, as it is an indispensable endeavor of the church for a relevant ministerial formation. At the same time, through various educational exposures and capacity building programs, the college is committed to build an ecumenical relationship, ecological awareness, society oriented ministry and a wholesome understanding of God (i.e., a reflection of God-Human-Nature Relationship). In brief, based on biblical-theological and Christian teachings (Ethics), college is committed to discern the signs of the time as well as equally devoted to learn and teach the updated global theological academia.

Mission Statement

Courses Offer by the College with required qualification:

1. Residential Courses:

(a) Bachelor of Divinity: (10 +2 Passed): 5 Years
(b) Bachelor of Divinity: (Secular Graduates): 4 Years
(c) Bachelor of Divinity: (B. Th. Upgrades): 2 Years

- (d) Available of application form from 1st September every year.
- (e) Last date of submission of application form to the college office: 15th November and with late fine 15th December every year.
- (f) For May, last date of submission of application form to the college office: 31st March and with late fine 15th April every year.

2. External/Non-Residential/ Correspondence Courses

- (a) Diploma of Christian Studies: +2 pass or 10 pass with 3 years of experience: 2-4 years
- (b) Bachelor of Christian Studies: Graduate: 4 -7 years of duration.
- (c) Last Date of Submission of Application Form to the Senate Office: 31st October every year and with late fine 30^{th} November every year.

Multiple Opportunities through Theological Education

The college focuses to make a balance between *oracle* and *professional* in theological education. Entering theological colleges/education is not only a call for sacred pastoral/ordained ministry, but, it creates and becomes a means of multiple opportunities for one's life-career. Theological education brings a discussion about various insights and perspectives both ancient and modern. Knowing and understanding these will help the students to create new vision and have new outlooks for new ideas which can change and transform the life. The students of theology not only study the Bible (or doing biblical studies), but they also study various subjects such as: Philosophy, Major Religions, Other Faiths and Dialogue, Church History, Mission and Ecumenism, Christian Theology (doctrines and dogma: Orthodox, Catholic, Lutheran, Pentecostal, etc.) and other Contextual/Liberation Theologies, Church Ministry, Worship and Preaching, Psychology & Counselling, Socio-analysis (related to the issues of Adivasi, Dalit, Women, Development and Ecology), Languages (English, Greek, Hebrew), Communication,

Multi-Media, Computer, Leadership and Management, Training for Skill and Personality Development, etc.

Apart from the *academic curricula* (learning from the classrooms teachings), the student gets many opportunities to interact with the people/congregations living in different life-settings such as: urban-industrial, semi-urban, rural, tea-garden, slums, Diasporas like migration, displacement, etc. The students also get orientation to know more about NGOs or Church-based organizations and institutions. In addition, the students of GTC get opportunities to broaden their horizon of understanding through exposure program/visit to abroad (Germany or other countries) for both short-term and long-term during or after their period of study. In other words, the college tries to provide a multiple opportunities *in* and *through* theological education.

Admission Procedure

Entrance Test and Personal interview will be conducted for the selection of candidates. The medium of entrance test will be both English and Hindi. The minimum age of the candidate must be <u>18 Years</u>, during the time of admission. Candidates are instructed to study the following subjects for the Entrance Test:
